

We are committed to offering inspiring live music and events – in a way that is safe and responsible.

Messina A. Corelli Conservatory of Music is monitoring the progress of COVID-19 closely. We are following all National Health of Italy, Public Health Ministry guidelines, and implementing all recommendations to protect the health of our audiences, students, artists, faculty, staff, and community members.

All concerts and events have significantly reduced capacity. We are adhering to current government regulated capacity limits for indoor events.

There are new procedures in place, including the following:

- Physical Distancing everywhere in the building and concert halls
- Mandatory masks everywhere in the building, including during concerts
- Mandatory temperature checks for everyone before entering the building
- A Waiver and a Health Questionnaire must be completed by all visitors before entering the building
- Seating is facilitated at the discretion of our ushers to ensure safe distancing. Seating designations are final.
- Washrooms will be available before and after performance
- No intermissions, to minimize gatherings and lines
- No food and beverage services
- No merchandise tables
- Hand sanitizers and disinfectant wipes are available throughout the building, particularly in high traffic areas, including at all entrances and exits, the box office, as well as in the lobbies and bars.
- Increased cleaning schedule of surfaces, handrails, doorknobs, handles, elevator keypads, ticketing office counter, bars, etc.
- Thorough and frequent cleaning of all concert halls, including armrests after every concert/event.
- Cleaning microphones and any other appropriate gear and production equipment.
- Additional precautionary measures
- All ticket holders will receive a “What to Expect” email with more details, before each concert you attend.

Staff are trained to support you, ensure your safety, and help you navigate the new procedures.
